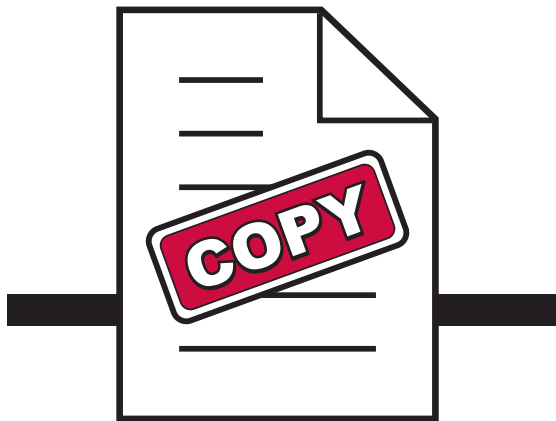


GOVERNMENT DOCUMENTS, IDENTIFICATION AND OTHER OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS

COPYRIGHTS

The U.S. Constitution directs Congress to promote the arts and sciences. From that phrase we derive laws governing copyrights and trademarks.

The copyright laws give authors, artists and other creators of works the rights to copy work, distribute copies, prepare versions or updates of originals and perform or display the work.

Copyright protection attaches automatically when work is fixed in a tangible medium. Examples include:

- photo prints & negatives
- child's finger painting
- all drafts
- finished books

No notice is required for copyright protection.

Types of copyrights:

- literary works (books, poems)
- blueprints/architectural works
- musical works (sheet music and sound recording)
- dramatic works
- newspapers, magazines
- pantomimes, choreography
- pictorials, graphics, sculptures
- videotapes, CDs, DVDs, cassettes
- computer software
- cartoons

Copyrights last for the life of the author plus 70 years, or 95 years if created by a corporation.

To reproduce or alter copyrighted material, we must have written permission from the copyright owner. Without written permission we cannot perform the work.



TRADEMARKS

A trademark includes any word, name, symbol or device, or any combination thereof, used by a person or company to identify and distinguish their goods or services. Trademark owners have protections under law to restrict the reproduction of their trademarks.

In order to reproduce a trademark, we must have written permission from the trademark owner.



CURRENCY AND NEGOTIABLE INSTRUMENTS

The following may only be reproduced in black and white, enlarged to 150% or reduced to 75% of the original, and single sided:

- paper money
- postage stamps
- money orders
- travelers checks
- personal or company checks
- receipts
- any negotiable instrument
